#### **Contact Details Confirmation**

#### **Timetables**

Students no longer need to attend tutor after Easter. One to one tutorials will continue to be available to them as needed. Formal lessons end on **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May**, with our Leavers pizza lunch. Teaching staff will be available during timetabled lessons until the exams finish and students are strongly encouraged to take advantage of this support.

## Pizza Lunch, Yearbooks and Hoodies

We will distribute year books and hoodies at the Leavers' pizza lunch on Friday 3rd May at school. Students are reminded that they are not expected to attend lessons period 5 if they have one.

# Leavers' Event at the Cosy Club - Monday 24th June

The vast majority of students in Year 13 have now bought their Leavers' event ticket. Tickets remain available until Friday 31st May; it would be fantastic to see the whole year group at the Cosy Club to celebrate the end of their Highcliffe journey. Students who have yet to return their medical form to the star room are reminded to do so as soon as possible please.

### **Contingency Day**

Students and parents are reminded of the standard examination contingency day on **Wednesday 26**<sup>th</sup> **June**. Please could you bear this date in mind when planning for this summer. Should any exams need to be moved to the contingency day students must be available to attend or they will be deemed absent and therefore not achieve a mark/grade for that component. Two additional afternoon contingency sessions have also been introduced for the 2024 exams. These are on **Thursday 6**<sup>th</sup> **June 2024** and **Thursday 13**<sup>th</sup> **June 2024**.

#### **Collection of Exam Results**

Results day this year is **Thursday 15th August 2024**. Exam results will be available from 9.00 am – 10.00 am in the grass area outside the entrance to Da Vinci. If it is raining on the day, we will relocate to the HALL. Results will also be available on-line in AT5 at 8:45am if students wish to view their results early before results envelopes are distributed. We trust this will be a happy experience for all but, if advice is required, Senior and Sixth Form staff will be available for advice and support in AT5 from 9am – 11am. It is advisable that a parent be available for students to contact on Results day if they need to reconsider their next steps.

Please be advised that, if you are unable to pick up your exam results in person, then you should either:

- Notify us, in writing, by using the form which can be found in the 'Certificates and Results'

  another person to collect your results on your behalf.
- The nominated person collecting results MUST bring the signed form together with a form of ID
- No results can be given out by telephone under any circumstances.

If you are unable to collect your results or nominate a representative, they will be available on MyHighcliffe from around noon on Results day.

For students who receive their last decision on or before 16 May 2024, the reply date is 6 June 2024 (except if using Extra to find a place).

For students who receive their last decision on or before 17 July 2024, the reply date is 24 July 2024 (including Extra choices)

**Remember that** your insurance choice should act as a back-up option, and therefore have <u>lower entry requirements</u> in case you do not get the grades you were expecting and miss out on your firm choice.
