We are pleased to inform you that we have arranged an opportunity for our music students who are interested in Music Production to supplement their music studies as a possible pathway through GCSE.

In the lead up to study at GCSE level we wish to offer Music Production tuition to enable students to attain a graded exam with the RSL board. Students who study Music Performance invest in tuition on their specialist instrument outside of the classroom and we feel that this opportunity should be extended to those who wish to master the creative use of music technology. Access to extra-curricular tuition specialising in Music Production will directly impact on students' success at GCSE.

The school has arranged a 14-week course which will be taught during Music Enrichment sessions taking place each Thursday between 8.25am-9am throughout the autumn term and first half of spring term.
