Sustrans Pedal Pass-On

As part of our efforts to encourage and support more young people and families to cycle to school, we will be taking part in the Sustrans Pedal Pass-On programme. Sustrans will be collecting old and unwanted bicycles, fixing them up and then redistributing them to children and families who most need them.

If you have a bicycle (child or adult) that you no longer need and you'd like to donate, the Sustrans team and myself will be collecting them at school on the morning of **Tuesday 12th December**. Parents/Carers can deliver bikes via the pedestrian entrance by the bike sheds. Sustrans welcomes donations of complete bikes as well as bike parts that could be used. Please be aware that they may have to politely decline if the bicycle is beyond the point of being repairable!

If you would be interested in receiving one of the refurbished bikes for your child or yourself, please complete the interest form attached and pass it to the Sustrans officer. They will be taking information to try to match people with suitable bikes. Please bear in mind that even if you donate a bicycle, Sustrans cannot **guarantee** that they will be able to provide you with a suitable bicycle from those they are able to repair.

They hope to start distributing the bikes from January 2024 to families at Highcliffe School who are in the most need of a working bike.


